Public Comments

- Mr. Bretemps of Upshur St. state that proposed bike lanes on 38th Street are not practical. Recommends bikes should be kept off main thoroughfare and put on safer less travelled streets. Regarding permit parking, Mr. Bretemps stated current law is adequate.
- Mr. Clark of Perry St. requested that list of minutes to be approved be added to agenda. Suggested to ask the old committee who conducted a study regarding where a bike lane would be best. Suggested that the town look into using some of the trees owed by the county from the levee project be used when planting trees during the Allison Street sidewalk repair project.
- Mr. Moomau of 38th St is concerned with the talks about placing a bike lane on 38th St. Suggested that Rhode Island Ave be considered another option.
- Ms. Robin of Varnum St expressed concerns with the parking challenges on Varnum St. Stated that many driveways get blocked by another vehicle.

- a) Update on meeting with SHA about 38th St Bike Lane -Town administrator requested plans/drawings. Once received a presentation will be made to residents.


