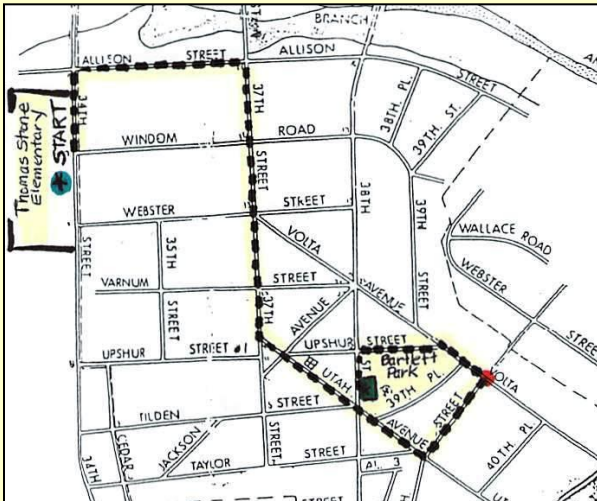

CODE ENFORCEMENT

It's that time of year! Please be mindful of cutting your grass and weeding along fence lines. Be kind to your pets. If it is hot outside keep your pets indoors and clean your pet waste. All dogs need to be on a leash when you are walking them.

Please make sure your household is following the Town's Code for trash removal. Having loose bags of trash placed out creates unsanitary conditions and increases the likely hood of rodents and insects to your property and the surrounding area.

§ 252-2 Container requirements- Water tight 30Gallon capacity not bigger. It shall stay covered and placed adjacent to a public street or alley, where it will be collected. The garbage cannot be allowed to become putrid.

§ 252-4 Times of Placement Restricted-Trash containers shall not be left at the property adjacent to a public street or alley overnight, weekends or holidays.

You can be cited and fined if you are not in compliance. Thank you to those residents who maintain their property. You are making Brentwood a cleaner, safer and healthier place to live.

OFFICINA DE CODIGOS

¡Su esa época del año! Por favor, ser conscientes de cortar el pasto y desmalezado lo largo de líneas de la cerca. Sea amable con sus mascotas. Si hace calor fuera de mantener a sus mascotas en el interior. Desechos de las mascotas deben ser limpiados y todos los perros deben ir atados cuando se está caminando.

Por favor, asegúrese de que su hogar está siguiendo Código de la Ciudad para la recolección de basura. Tener bolsas sueltas de basura colocados fuera crea condiciones insalubres y aumenta también la probabilidad de roedores e insectos a su propiedad y sus alrededores.

§ 252-2 Requisitos de Contenedor de Basura- Capacidad de 30 Gallones no más grande. Será estadia cubierta y se coloca al lado de una calle o callejón público, en el que se recogerán. La basura no se puede permitir llegar a ser pútrido.

§ 252-4 Los tiempos de los contenedores de basura de colocación restringida - no deberán ser dejados en la propiedad adyacente a la vía pública o callejón durante la noche, fines de semana o días de fiesta.

Puede ser citado y multado si no está de acuerdo.

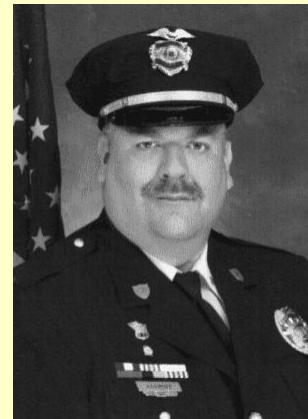
