TOWN OF BRENTWOOD

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRENTWOOD
AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF THE FY-2013 BUDGET, AND PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS,
SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Town Charter, Chapter 6, Section 603.0, states if the budget is not approved by July 1, a majority vote of the Council shall be necessary to extend the current budget for a single thirty day period; and

WHEREAS, The Town Charter, Chapter 6, Section 603.0 states that expenditures for that period shall not exceed one-twelfth of the annual expenses provided in the budget of the previous fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the FY-2014 budget was prepared and adopted in the form of an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Charter, Chapter 4, Section 404.0, states every ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of thirty calendar days following passage by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the FY-2014 budget was adopted at a Special Meeting on June 11, 2013 and therefore shall not be effective until July 11, 2013.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRENTWOOD,
THE FOLLOWING:**

SECTION ONE: That the current budget of FY-2013 is extended until July 11, 2013.

SECTION TWO: Those expenditures for that period shall not exceed one-twelfth of the annual expenses provided in the FY-2013 budget.

SECTION THREE: CONFLICTS: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any other Resolution and any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.



SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.






