
## Windom Road Historic Barrier Park

Brentwood received Chesapeake Bay Trust Prince George's County Stormwater grant to complete the innovative green infrastructure at Windom Road with tree trenches and permeable pavers.

Target to begin construction: May – June  
Target tree & native plant planting: mid-June

- Bi-weekly meetings with Town of North Brentwood and Neighborhood Design Center
- Held kick-off meeting with CBT
- Met with Anacostia Trails Heritage Area to pursue sponsorship




